Proposed Waiver of *Senate Rules 3.2.3.B* ("Procedures for Processing Academic Programs and Changes," "Procedures to be Used," "Approval by Academic Council") for Academic Programs with Nonstandard CIP Codes

Over a period of years, about 13 University academic programs were approved by Senate with a (nonstandard) eight-digit CIP code. Kentucky's Council on Postsecondary Education has asked that the eight-digit CIPs be replaced with the six-digit CIP that is customarily used.

<u>Recommended motion</u>: that SC waive Senate Rules 3.2.3.B to allow an expedited program change process (requiring approval by the department and college and placement on a Senate web transmittal, skipping any academic council) for the academic programs that were inadvertently approved with an eight-digit CIP code instead of the customary, six-digit CIP code.
