The student had completed all of the requirements for Bachelor of Liberal Studies degree by the end of the Fall 2017 semester.

The Bachelor of Liberal Studies degree is a new degree program approved in October 2016. When this new program was first coded into SAP it was, in error, listed as *Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Studies* instead of *Bachelor of Liberal Studies*.

During the short time period it took to correct this error this student declared the major and was listed as a Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Studies major in the December 2017 degree list.

The student was awarded the Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Studies in December 2017 – a degree that does not exist.

Due to the aforementioned administrative error, the College of Arts & Sciences requests that the Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Studies degree awarded in December 2017 be rescinded, and the Bachelor of Liberal Studies degree (Dec 2017) be awarded.
