Goals & Benefits



- Better ability to account for devices using UK network
 - Isolate non-UK customers
- Help mitigate increasing cyber threats
- Data loss prevention



eduroam



For students, faculty, and staff

- Primary wireless network
- Two ways to connect:
 - Onboarding at www.uky.edu/wifihelp (Preferred method)
 - Manually using linkblue credentials
- Visitors from participating higher education institutions will have guest level access



UK-Guest



For visitors to the UK Campus

- Provides guest level Internet with limited access to UK resources
- Guest account obtained in two ways:
 - Self-registration through portal that launches when you connect to UK-Guest
 - Provided by a UK Sponsor



UK-Guest



For visitors to the UK Campus

- Sponsorship
 - Authorized UK Faculty and Staff may become "Sponsors" for guest WiFi access
 - Can create bulk guest accounts for conferences or longer term access for contractors/vendors



UK-Devices



For IoT devices that cannot use eduroam

- Non-broadcast, secure wireless network for IoT devices that are not able to authenticate through eduroam
 - Wireless door locks, smart TVs, shared devices, etc.
- Requires registration process and connection with a pre-shared key



UK-WiFi-Help



For use once ukyedu is disabled

- Will allow access to www.uky.edu/wifihelp and eduroam onboarding after ukyedu is disabled
- Can also be used as a reference tool that provides more information on the different networks

Timeline

- December 2017
 - ITS moved the bulk of campus AP's to the new switch and controller infrastructure

 - Elimination of ukyedu SSID after Spring semester grades have been submitted
