Background Information for Proposal

<i>Agenda Item Name:</i>	Change to BS Digital Media Design
<i>Rationale for proposal:</i>	This proposal seeks to change a degree program that was started in 2016. The proposal is from a steering committee of faculty and students reviewing the program. The changes include: Moving a 3D art studio (103) to the first year curriculum; changing electives from 18 credit hours of “outside concentrations” to 15 credit hours of “outside explorations” to free up 3 credit hours for the 3D art studio course in the first year of the program; restricting the number of studio courses that a student can take to 3 to ensure that students are completing the program on time and with the skills needed to graduate, students can request to take an additional studio course with advisor approval; change to GCCR course (course change is currently in the review process).
