The Senate Rules 1) describe the University Senate's oversight of the calendar and 2) charge the Senate Council (executive body of the University Senate) with reviewing deviations from the Senate-approved calendar. The Senate Calendar Committee is charged with conducting a comprehensive review of all calendar-related requests and will provide recommendations to the Senate Council on whether or not to approve such requests.

The Calendar Committee will not ordinarily recommend approval of outright waivers for academic holidays and University holidays. Substitute dates may be proposed if the original dates are not maintained. Further, changes in perpetuity are unlikely to be approved.
