**Background Information for Proposal**

<i>Agenda Item Name:</i>	<b>Waiver of SR 2.1.2.3 and 2.1.2.5</b>
<i>Rationale for proposal:</i>	<p>Allowing a week between the spring and summer semester is less restrictive than Senate Rule 2.1.2.3 and 2.1.2.5 and more amenable for the campus overall.</p> <p>I am requesting a waiver of Senate Rule 2.1.2.3 Summer Session and 2.1.2.5 Summary (specifically related to when summer session begins), in order to expedite approval of the 2023-2024 Academic Calendar. The rationale for the waiver request is that a week between the spring and summer semester in the 2023-2024 Academic Calendar, which is less restrictive than Senate Rule 2.1.2.3 and 2.1.2.5, is more amenable for the campus overall. There is a structural calendar used by the Registrar and shared with the Senate that has these dates, which were used to build out the comprehensive 2023-2024 Academic Calendar that was submitted to the Senate Office on August 25, 2022.</p>
