Background Information for Proposal

<i>Agenda Item Name:</i>	Change to SR 4.2.2.2.1 ("Grad Schl," "Intern'l Apps") [GRE/GMAT]
<i>Rationale for proposal:</i>	GRE/GMAT test scores are required for Graduate School admissions unless a program has specifically dropped them. As of last spring, only 25% of graduate programs still required GRE/GMAT scores. This proposal removes the GRE/GMAT requirement generally while allowing individual program to maintain this as a requirement for admissions. This proposal also updates the language in the SR regarding the English proficiency requirement for international applicants.
