General Survey Information

- Survey population consisted of all full-time faculty.
 - Survey emailed through REDcap, a secure, web-based application developed at Vanderbilt.
- Survey recipients were informed that the results would be shared with President Capilouto and the Board of Trustees, and posted on the University Senate Council website.
- Survey responses were anonymous, but whether or not an individual had responded was tracked by REDcap.
 - Survey tool automatically sent reminders to those who had not responded.

General Survey Info, continued


- The survey window was two weeks long, running from April 18 through May 2, 2013.
- 2,530 faculty received the survey.
- There were 807 responses, yielding a response rate of 31.9%.

Survey Design

- Survey contained 16 statements to which a respondent offered an opinion via the options below.
 - Strongly agree
 - Disagree
 - Neither agree nor disagree
 - Agree
 - Strongly agree
 - Choose not to respond
- There were also two questions which allowed free text answers.
 - "What is the President's most significant achievement?"
 - "What should the President focus on to improve his effectiveness?"
















