This is a recommendation that the University Senate approve the suspension of admission into an existing graduate certificate program: Clinical Research Skills in the Department of Preventative Medicine & Environmental Health within the College of Public Health.

There is general enthusiasm for finding a way of providing more flexible certificate training options for CTS scholars, but the curriculum committee felt that adding a second certificate to the department at this time would be confusing and labor intensive. That said, they also felt that adding a more flexible track within the Certificate in Clinical & Translational Science was not a good idea. My impression is that the Department may develop a second certificate program at some point, but that now is not the right time to do so.
