Rationale:

With the reforms in general education and the constraints of 120 hours from CPE, it was nearly impossible to graduate with a BS in Philosophy within 4 years. Very few of the majors ever pursued the BS; most opted for the BA. The BA option will still continue and will be the route promoted by the college and department.
