- 2,540 Cameras
- 7,728 Access Control Points
- 42 Talk-A-Phone Towers (Blue Phones)
- 65 Police Officers



Accomplishments

- New Video Management Software (VMS)
 - More resilient
 - Involves partnership between UKPD & UKIT
 - Will allow new cameras to be added a lower cost
 - Allow for easier growth and expansion



Accomplishments

- Maxwell Street Corridor
 - Cameras
 - Talk-A-Phone Towers

- Installation complete of new access control software
- Door access control projects are included as part of building renovation projects




- Livesafe Mobile Safety App
 - "Your personal Blue Phone"
- Upgraded Radio system
 - Combined 5 disparate radio systems into a campus wide radio system
 - Allows for interoperable communications
- Increasing Sworn staff to be inline with University growth



- Replaced Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) software
 - Partnership with Rapid SOS to allow 911 locations from cell phone calls
 - Increasing our educational outreach programs
 - STARR
 - Active Aggressor
 - EOC Team Training
 - See Something, Say Something

UKPR Bomb Threat AAR

- At the table early and in close communication with police and administration, giving us the ability to prepare more proactively
- Sent email notifications and monitored and posted on social media throughout the night/morning
- Quickly pulled together a news conference and did so before classes began and morning news ended



UKPR Bomb Threat AAR

Observations:

- GroupMe private mass messaging
- Students and parents expect to hear from us directly rather than news media
- Confusion on what "unsubstantiated" means when arrest not yet made
- UK Alert misunderstood
- Kernel reporters' dual role of students + journalists



UKPR Bomb Threat AAR

Working on:

- Being even more proactive with initial messaging
- Sending out more substantive email to parents sooner
- Livestreaming news conference on UK's Facebook
- Using more straightforward language, remind people more can't be said because of ongoing investigation
- Increasing awareness of when and why UK Alert is or is not used
