Strategic Plan Steering Committee

- Faculty, staff, and students to serve as internal reviewers and collaborators to evaluate initiatives
- The Executive Committee, the Steering Committee, and subject matter experts will engage in workshops to update progress on key goals; discuss threats, potential disruptions, and opportunities; and evaluate, refine, and develop proposed bold initiatives
- Based on joint workshops with the Executive Committee and the Steering Committee, three-to-five potential bold initiatives will be identified for more detailed development

• Full Development of Bold Initiatives

- Teams of subject matter experts and representatives from units responsible for implementation will fully develop the selected bold initiatives via "white papers" on each initiative
- Details include key goals and corresponding objectives, tactics, and performance metrics
- The Executive Committee, the Steering Committee, and subject matter experts will "workshop" the selected bold initiatives and craft the corresponding "white papers" into a draft Strategic Plan

Exposing Bold Initiatives and Receiving Input

- Draft Strategic Plan and "white papers" will be rolled out to campus in early fall
- Forums will be held on each bold initiative for discussion and feedback
- Technology will be used to "crowdsource" campus feedback
- Draft Plan will be revised in response to feedback
