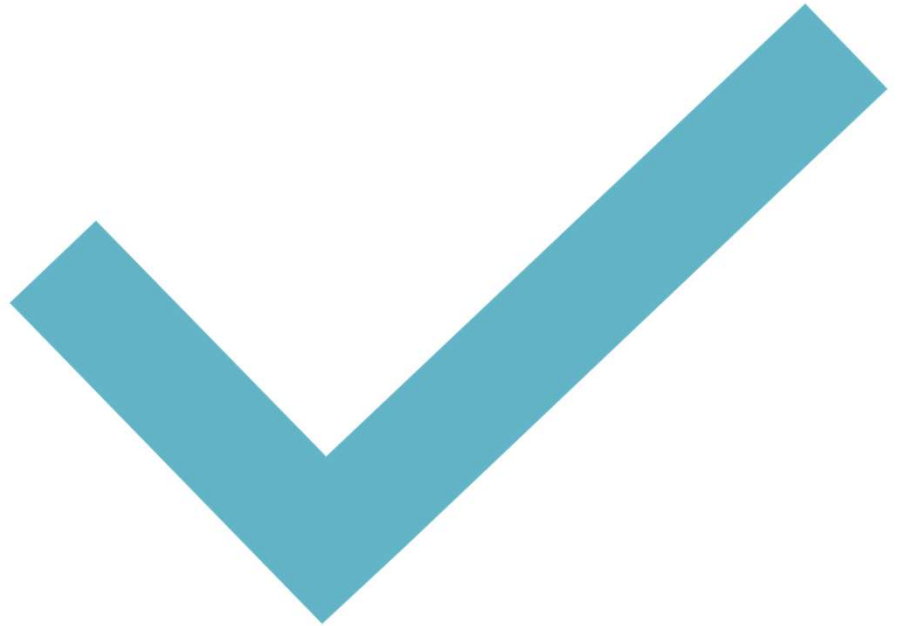
PROPOSAL SUMMARY
